Yes

Staff must work side by side or facing away from each other not face to face if possible, otherwise, operators must be supplied with appropriate PPE including face shields and masks. Consider the use of screens between workstations. Monitor high-traffic areas and reduce staff movement and volume where possible, including restrooms, communal areas.

#### **Define Controls Required**

Whilst staff are at the work stations they are all 2 mtr apart but when they leave their work stations there is a risk this could be infringed. When staff leave their work stations they must wear a face shield at all times.

# Are Numbers of Staff During Breaks or In Enclosed Areas Monitored To Reduce Exposure?

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NB: Social distancing and reduced numbers of personnel MUST be maintained to reduce risk of virus spread. Consider introduction of staggered break times and seating in domestic areas to maintain suitable distancing along with erection of screens where necessary to ensure segregation.

Production canteens have social distancing floor marker laid down to confirm 2 mtr distancing. All apposing chairs have been removed that face each other and tables are spaced a minimum 1-2 mtr apart. Tables all have sneeze screens fitted.

Smoking shelter is external to building with very good fresh air supply, good signage confirming social distancing of 2 Mtr to be maintained at all times.

# Risk of Employees Spreading Virus By Living or Travelling Together

NB: Identify Staff living together or travelling to work together. Staff should be assigned to the same shift teams to limit social interaction.

Increase the frequency of cleaning procedures, pausing production in the day to allow for all workstations to be disinfected.

#### Identify the type of exposure

Car sharing

Risk rating Medium

#### Enter control measures (Mitigation)

All staff have been asked that if they car share that they should take the following precautions. share the transport with the same people each time, keep to groups of up to the legal limit of 6. Open windows for ventilation and distance as far as is practicable, clean car between journeys including door handles and other areas that people may touch, make sure the driver and passengers wear a face covering.

All staff have been advised to keep themselves informed with the latest NHS advise on covid 19 when outside of work, where any of the above is not possible inform RDC ASAP.

#### **Risk Mitigation 2**

#### Identify the type of exposure

Staff that live together

Risk rating Low

#### **Enter control measures (Mitigation)**

Where staff live or travel together to and from work they are advised to stay in their own bubbles, and not migrate where possible with other members of staff. These staff all work on the same shift patterns, and where possible all take breaks together.

### Risk of Employees Contracting Virus Whilst at Work

NB: Possible hazards may be connected to poor hygiene, infection from outside the workplace or existing symptoms. Staff should be assigned to the same shift teams to limit social interaction.

Increase the frequency of cleaning procedures, pausing production in the day to allow for all workstations to be disinfected.

#### Enter control measures (Mitigation)

#### Enter control measures (Mitigation)

Production canteens have social distancing floor marker laid down to confirm 2 mtr distancing. All chairs have been removed that face each other, and tables are spaced a minimum 1-2 mtr apart. Tables will have sneeze screens fitted as soon as they arrive they are currently on back order.

#### **Risk Mitigation 5**

#### Identify the type of exposure

Spreading virus via production products etc

Risk rating Low

#### **Enter control measures (Mitigation)**

Gloves are worn throughout RDC these include leather rigger gloves/neoprene gloves/cut resistant gloves and throw away latex gloves. There are no restriction on glove usage and these are disposed on in the appropriate way as required. RDC also have hand sanitizer stations at all entry points to the building and randomly around the factory floor.

#### **Risk Mitigation 6**

#### Identify the type of exposure

Airborne contamination

Risk rating Low

#### **Enter control measures (Mitigation)**

Social distancing is enforced throughout site ensuring a 2 mtr distancing where this is not possible face shields/masks are worn.

#### **Risk Mitigation 7**

#### Identify the type of exposure

Staff training where close contact is unavoidable.

Risk rating Medium

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Where staff training is required all staff will wear face masks or face shields, training time will be kept to absolute minimum, under 15 minutes maximum. Gloves will also been worn during this time if required.

#### **Risk Mitigation 8**

#### Identify the type of exposure

Vulnerable high risk staff members

Risk rating Medium

#### **Enter control measures (Mitigation)**

Where staff have informed RDC of being at high risk, including health reasons or family health reasons etc, these will be looked at on an individual basic including allowing staff to work from home if possible, or taking extra precautions whilst they are onsite. All staff have received a letters asking them to confirm if they are consider high risk see "Covid 19 Plan" dated 14/03/20

NB: Possible hazards may be connected to poor hygiene, infection from outside the workplace or existing symptoms.

#### **Risk Mitigation**

#### **Risk Mitigation 1**

#### Identify the type of exposure

External visitors

Risk rating Low

#### Enter control measures (Mitigation)

All visits to RDC are refused currently unless it is deemed an absolute necessity. Where visitors do come to site, they will be held in reception until they have completed RDC "visitors questionnaire" if they answer "Yes" to any of the questions the visit will be refused immediately. They will also be asked on entry to hand sanitize and wear a mask at all times, they are also asked to use RDC registered NHS covid 19 QR Scanner. Visitors will then be collected by a member of RDC staff, who will confirm they have hand sanitize and ensure they are wearing a mask throughout complete visit.

#### **Risk Mitigation 2**

#### Identify the type of exposure

Transmission of infection through body contact articles ie laptops/pens/books etc

Risk rating Low

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All visitors are asked to not transfer/share any articles ie laptops/pens/brochures etc whilst on-site, if they do need to leave these items for any reason they will be quarantined for 48 hours before release.

#### **Risk Mitigation 3**

#### Identify the type of exposure

Visitors leaving items on-site

Risk rating Low

#### **Enter control measures (Mitigation)**

All visitors are asked to take all of the items away with them when leaving and leave nothing on-site including PPE etc.

## Risk of Employees Travelling to Other Areas on Business or Leisure

NB: Possible hazards may be connected to poor hygiene or quarantine restrictions in area visited, infection from areas outside the workplace or existing symptoms.

#### Identify the type of exposure

Staff visiting other sites

Risk rating Low

#### **Enter control measures (Mitigation)**

All staff at RDC are restricted from off site visits currently, where it is essential then a further risk assessment will be carried out. At minimum this will include hand sanitizing before entering/leaving other sites and face masks worn at all times. No transmission or any articles ie laptops pens etc to take place.

#### **Risk Mitigation 2**

#### Identify the type of exposure

Staff travelling to high risk Covid 19 areas

Risk rating Medium

#### Enter control measures (Mitigation)

All staff are informed to talk to RDC before travelling to any high risk covid 19 areas. If this travel is essential then staff will have to self-isolate in accordance with the NHS guidelines at time of travel/return.

In all areas of RDC gloves are worn by staff including leather rigger gloves, cut resistant gloves or disposable gloves. Staff do not share gloves and when required are issued with new gloves, and the old gloves disposed of in a safe manner. We also have several hand sanitizer stations through out the company

#### **Risk Mitigation 2**

#### Identify the type of exposure

Staff work stations

Risk rating Low

#### Enter control measures (Mitigation)

All office staff are asked to ensure they disinfect their work stations at the end of each shift this includes work tables/keyboard/phones etc

## Are All Staff Following Regular Personal Hygene Measures?

#### Identify the type of exposure

Personal hygiene and general factory hygiene

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Risk rating Low

#### Enter control measures (Mitigation)

RDC has a full time cleaner who has been informed to constantly go around cleaning all common touch points and work surfaces, ie door handles/banister rails etc. These are cleaned with the use of antibacterial sprays. Also all floors are constantly being cleaned to ensure good hygiene. All staff also wear gloves through production so there is no hand contact with production items.

#### **Risk Mitigation 2**

#### Identify the type of exposure

Office staff hygiene

Risk rating Low

#### Enter control measures (Mitigation)

All office staff have their own terminals none are shared terminals, in the unlikely event of shared terminals staff are asked to disinfect the keyboard/mouse and any other ancillaries after use.


